

KIWANIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE

To award a scholarship to Scappoose High School seniors to assist with their higher education. The Kiwanis Memorial Scholarship Fund is dedicated to the memory of deceased Scappoose Kiwanians.

AMOUNT

\$500-\$1000 depending on applications

ELIGIBILITY

Any Scappoose High School graduating senior who plans to pursue a full-time course of study at a college, university, or state approved vocational school.

CONSIDERATIONS

The following items will be considered in making the award:

1. Volunteer Community Service.....35%
2. Leadership and participation in school activities....20%
3. Scholarship Record.....15%
4. Active Key Club Member.....10%
5. Essay.....10%
6. Need.....10%
7. Applicants shall submit a current transcript, a letter of recommendation from a high school advisor and a letter of recommendation from a member of the community. Applicants shall also submit a short essay, 100 words or less, on what Community Service means to the applicant and why it is important.

SELECTION

1. Applicants may apply for the scholarship by completing the application form and returning it to the high school counseling office by May 15th
2. A selection committee composed of the Scappoose Kiwanis Club President and the Scholarship Committee will select the recipients.
3. The scholarships will be awarded at the graduation ceremony.

DISTRIBUTION

The awards shall be paid directly to the scholarship office of the student's college of choice and administered according to normal scholarship procedure as outlined by the office. Unused money will be returned to the Kiwanis Memorial Scholarship Fund.
