- Essay: Write an essay on the importance of peer leadership in high school athletics (300 words maximum). <u>Be creative</u> the judges will be reading several essays and you need to make yours stand out! Tell the judges a personal story about peer leadership; don't give them the Webster's definition of sportsmanship.
- Extra-Curricular Form: Focus on <u>significant</u> participation and leadership experiences, athletic achievements, academic awards and community involvement.
- Short-Answer Questions: Use this space to <u>tell us more</u> about how you've personally benefited by staying active

   both in school sports and in non-school activities.
- One Letter of Recommendation: Approach coaches, teachers, school administrators, youth group leaders or others in your community and have them write recommendation letters so the judges can <u>learn a little bit more</u> <u>about you</u>. There is a two page maximum for the letter.

- STAPLE the application in this order: three page application form, Essay, and then Recommendations. Do not attach certificates, awards or transcripts.
- Complete all four parts of the application. Incomplete applications will not be judged.
