- If you score high enough, it can count as meeting your essential skills graduation requirement for reading and math.

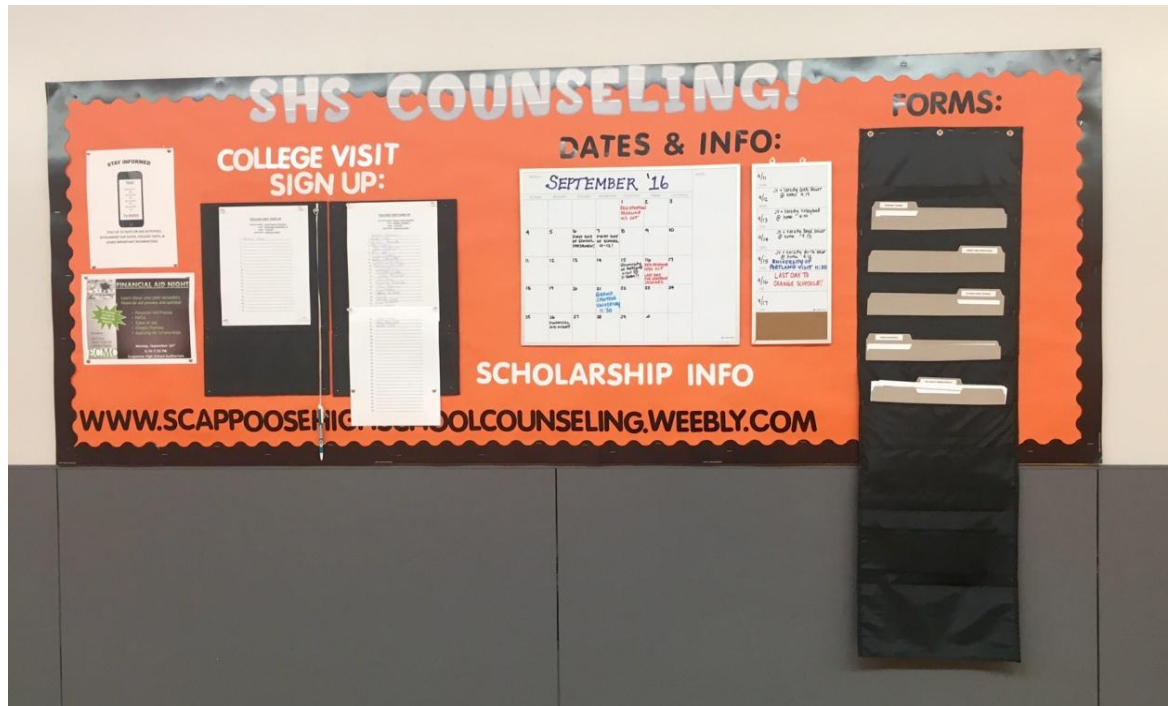

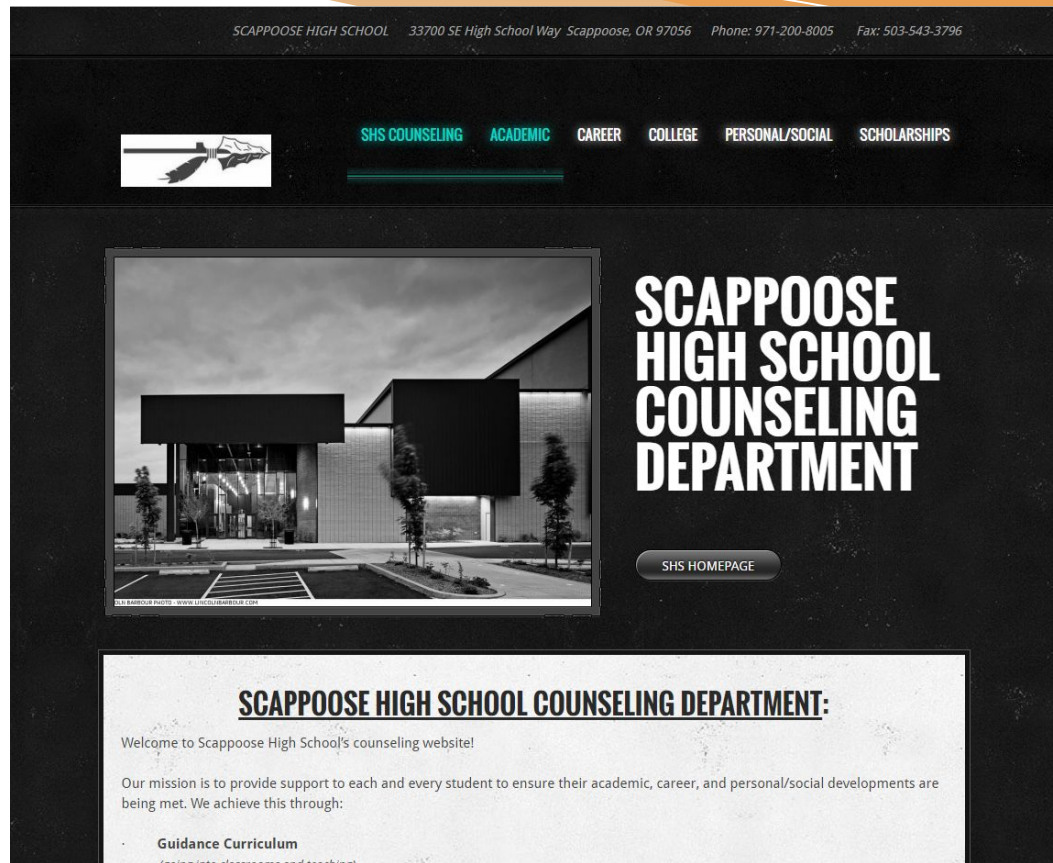

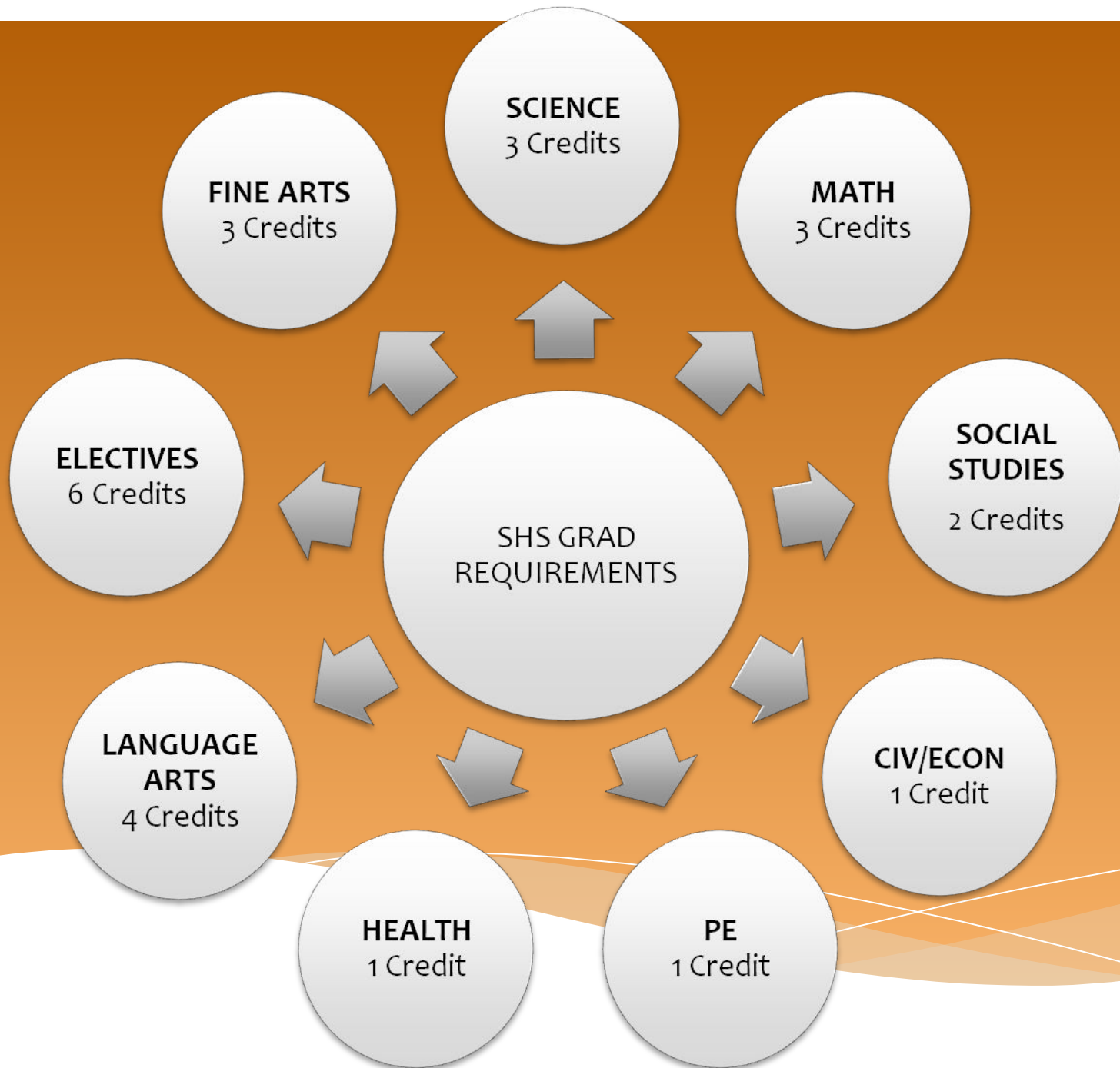
